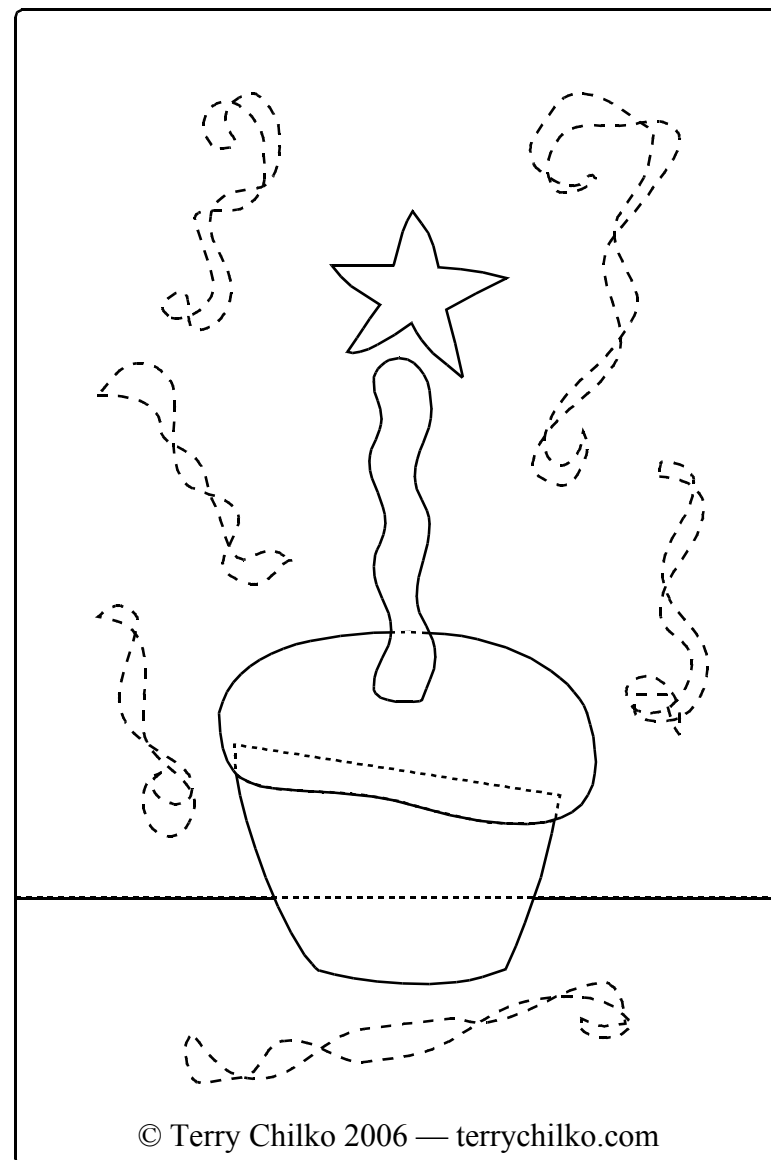


The drawing above is what the postcard will look like when finished.

The streamers to the right aren't appliques. They are an example of one quilting option.

The rays coming from the star flame to the left is another quilting option.



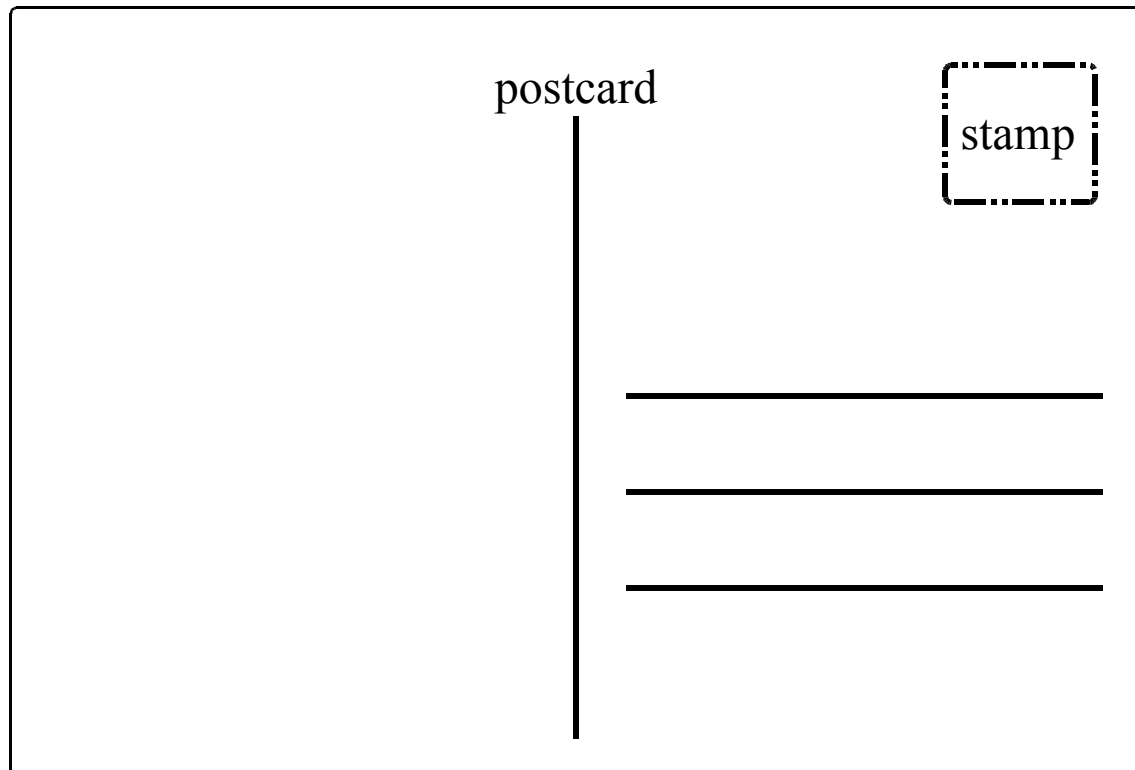
This drawing is reversed, ready to trace onto the paper side of paper backed fusible web. When tracing applique pattern pieces, add 1/4" underlaps to fabric edges that will be overlapped by other pattern pieces. Dotted lines show the applique underlaps.

Materials for each postcard quilt—

- Cotton fabrics for postcard front & back - cut slightly larger than 4" x 6" each
- Fabric scraps for appliques
- Paper backed fusible web - 2 pieces a little larger than 4" x 6" each for front and back, and a third piece about 5" x 6" for appliques
- Craft weight fusible interfacing - cut slightly larger than 4" x 6"
- Felt - cut slightly larger than 4" x 6"
- Threads for applique and quilting
